3. Project overview:

Dr. Nancy House, Assistant Professor of Art Education, with the help of Mr. Carl Twarog, Assistant Professor of Communication Arts, is in the process of constructing lesson plans and curriculum revisions to employ the Prism Visor in the teaching of Art 1001, Color and Design. The work will continue into fall, 2001 with the testing of several applications.

4. Budget summary:

The entire \$8,500 has been expended. There were 15 Prism Visors and the necessary Xircom wireless cards purchased prior to June 30, 2001.

5. Participants:

In addition to the primary individuals cited above, Dr. Phil Phillips, Associate Dean and Mr. Michael Dorsey, Dean are also involved in the project. The class will be offered for 15 non-major students in spring , 2002.
